## Cornell Compliance OUTSIDE INCOME STATEMENT FOR 2014-2015

Bylaw 11.2.2 requires all full-time and part-time staff members to provide a written detailed account annually to the University Chief Executive Officer for all athletically related income and benefits from sources outside the institution.

Staff members must report to the institutions Chief Executive Officer on:

- Receipt of all athletically related income and benefits FROM SOURCES OUTSIDE THE INSTITUTION.
- Personal gain received either directly or by implication in the usage of the institution's name or logo in the endorsement of commercial products or services.
- Acceptance of outside compensations or gratuities from athletic shoe, apparel or equipment manufacturers in exchange for use of such merchandise during practice or competition.
